Applications for Jardine Scholarship Award 2009 will open in mid August 2008. General application guidelines and schedule are listed as below for reference. Application forms and further details will be available from 15th August 2008.

Method of Application:

1. All applications must be submitted together with the following:
 - (i) A personal statement and description with particulars of the applicant's extra-curricular activities, including sports, and level of community involvement;
 - (ii) Certified copies of 'O' and 'A' level or equivalent certificates, e.g. HKCEE/GCE/SMP/STPM/STTB/STK;
 - (iii) 2 recent passport-size photographs;
 - (iv) Confirmation that they have applied for a place in one of the preferred Colleges at Oxford or Cambridge University (Oxford University: Exeter, Oriel, Queen's and Trinity; Cambridge University: Downing, Magdalene and Trinity); and
 - (v) Copies of completed UCAS and University application forms.
2. For applicants attending secondary school or junior college, applications must be submitted through the school principal and be supported by a testimonial signed by the school principal setting out:
 - (i) The applicant's academic record of examination results;
 - (ii) Remarks which will assist the Scholarship Committee to satisfy themselves that requirements as to special qualities have been met; and
 - (iii) Any other relevant information which will assist the Scholarship Committee in their assessment.
3. In all other cases applications in Hong Kong must be submitted, together with references, through the principal of the secondary school, or the equivalent, which applicants last attended.
4. For applicants studying overseas, advice should be given of their specific dates in Hong Kong from mid December 2008 to early January 2009.

Interviews:

1. Whilst the preliminary evaluation of each application will be based on the details submitted by applicants in writing, shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend the first interview in the middle of November 2008, when they will be screened by a selection committee whose decision will be final.
2. The final selection will require applicants to attend for a personal interview in early January 2009. Any applicant, who has not been invited for an interview before that date should consider the application unsuccessful.
